Fine Session: Mary Beth came up with some real estate questions which everyone found easy to answer. We thought she wasn't going to collect a dime until she asked us which architect designed the Sydney Opera House. That one stumped everyone and produced a rich harvest for Polio Plus.

Program

Our speaker today was Mike Muisenga of Berkshire Hathaway Prairie Path Realtors. First, Mike gave us an overview of the Elmhurst single family home market over the past seven years. In general, the number of homes sold last year (475) is down 24% since 2017. The average Sales Price of \$697,778 is up 32% over the same time. The main reason for this is that the supply of homes available is very low which pushes the prices up. Mortgage rate have risen from below 4% to almost 8%. Homeowners don't want to sell their home if their mortgage rate is less than 4% unless they have to. Rates have come down lately and are now around 6.3% for a 30-year mortgage. Mike has observed that the buyers of the high-end homes are coming from the City of Chicago, while the more modest ranches are being sold to in-town buyers. While discussing real estate taxes, Mike pointed out that 78% of your taxes go to School District 204. The new assessments will be coming out soon. Mike advised us, that if we want to appeal them, we should do it early and at the local level. He was recently notified that appeals can only be made by the homeowner or an attorney, not a realtor who has the most knowledge about the current market. He then

brought us up to date on the recent changes to the Buyer's Agent/Seller's Agent arrangement. The bottom line is that he thinks it will hurt the first-time homebuyer who is the one who is most in need of bring represented by an experienced agent.
